Proceeds from the sale fund environmental education programs for youth.

This event is a **seedling** sale whose primary offering is bare root tree seedlings. A bundle can be held in one hand. **There will be no cash refunds on plant stock. We must receive your order by Wed. April 14, 2010. No fax orders, please.** You must pick up your order at the Brady's Run Lodge. We do not deliver to you, and we are not responsible for unclaimed orders. We will mail you a reminder of the date and times when you may pick up your order. The reminder will contain a pick-up post card. **You must bring the postcard with you when you pick up your order.**

Austrian Pine 10-20" long dark green needles; extremely hardy; tolerates poor soil and air pollution. Ornamental, timber and Christmas tree. _____ _____

Serbian Spruce 18-24" Short, soft needles. Stays narrow, compact and dense; grows to 50 ft. Probably the most beautiful and adaptable of all the spruces. _____ _____

Canadian Hemlock 12-18" Lacy, short needles, tolerates shade well, likes moist soil. _____ _____

Deciduous Tree Seedlings—sold in bundles of five per variety

Pin Oak 12-18" Fast growing with grayish brown bark, beautiful green foliage turning yellow to radiant red in fall. Prefers somewhat moist soil. Grows to 75 ft. _____ _____

Northern Catalpa 12-24" Grows to 60' Heart shaped leaves 12" long; creamy white flowers bloom in late June. In late fall, long bean-like pods appear that reach 18 inches. Grows best in rich, moist soil but will tolerate an average dry soil. Fast growing; likes sun. _____ _____

White Flowering Dogwood 12-18" Grows to 40' Dense lustrous green foliage. Bright red berries are food for birds. Considered to be the best ornamental of all trees. _____ _____

Groundcovers—sold in bundles of 25 per variety minimum order is one bundle \$8.00 per bundle

Myrtle (vinca minor) Rooted cuttings Small shiny evergreen leaves with violet blue flowers in Spring. Sun or shade. Very hardy; good for hard to mow banks _____ _____

Pachysandra—Rooted cuttings Sun or shade, any soil. Very hardy _____ _____

Purple Coneflower a sturdy, robust native grows 24 to 36” high with large daisy-like purple to lavender flowers. Blooms all summer into autumn. Sun or part shade. A butterfly favorite. Drought tolerant.

Panorama Red Bee Balm Bright shaggy flower heads from red to crimson to dark rose. Blooms June through September. Tall, bushy plants with aromatic, mint-like foliage grows to a height of 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 feet with a spread of 3 to 4 feet. Likes cool, moist to even wet soils. Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.

Hen and Chicks Easy to grow even in poor soil. Height 4-6” Spread 6-12” Succulent foliage often brightly colored with crimson, purple and green shading; which forms rosettes of leaves surrounded by smaller rosettes or "chicks".

Miscellaneous

American Chestnut 8 to 14” bare root seedlings. Two seedlings should be planted within 50 yards of each other for proper pollination. Matures in 7 – 10 years. Supply is limited; offered on a first come, first served basis as orders are received by BCCD. \$20.00 per pair of seedlings; Limit 2 pair.

American Elderberry 18-24”. Very fast growing shrub. Grows to 10’ with 6-8’ spread. Berries are used for making wine, jelly and preserves. Also a food source for wildlife. Any soil. Bare root. \$1.75 each

Checkerberry Height 6” spreads to 18” Pinkish white, urn-shaped, nodding flowers May through summer. Followed by fleshy, red, edible berries relished by birds, chipmunks and other wildlife. The leaves as well as the berries emit a wintergreen odor when crushed. Likes acid soil. Also known as creeping wintergreen. Small potted - \$3.50 ea.
