



MAY 2025 WEST NILE VIRUS PROGRAM

May surveillance occurred at approximately 94 sites throughout the county. Various trapping techniques were employed, including 53 gravid traps that collected approximately 5,500 adult mosquitoes!



A total of 42 larval control events were conducted throughout the county to reduce the larval populations and 2 adult control events by thermal fogging were conducted to reduce large adult mosquito population. Beaver County reported 0 cases of WNV in May, but the first positive WNV reported mosquito sample was collected in April in eastern Pennsylvania.

Tick surveillance continued in May with 9 drags performed at various locations that yielded 25 nymphal ticks, 10 larval ticks, and 4 adult ticks.
